### **...AS WE SERVE OTHERS IN NEED**

**OFFICIAL BOARD** met Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm. The Board received a report on the condition of the Keates pipe organ from Robert Hiller of the Alan Jackson Co. Our organ is declining in function and has approximately 5-10 years of usable life left, before major work or replacement will be needed. The most long-lasting and economical solution may be future replacement with a fully refurbished organ of higher quality. Congregations are advised to begin setting aside funds 5-10 years in advance for an organ project.

The Financial Report for 2016 was reviewed as was the Proposed Budget Report for 2017. The Board members were distressed at having to present a deficit budget to the congregation and decided to reconvene Sunday, January 29 to discuss plans to present a Stewardship campaign.

M & P reported that Rev. Hewitt Holmes has been called by the congregation effective May 1, 2017.

Amendments were recommended to the Collier Street Church Constitution to replace Stewards with Property Committee and Finance Committee.

**OFFICIAL BOARD** reconvened Sunday, January 29, 2017 at 11:50 am. Details for the Congregational Timeline Workshop with Rev. Pegi Ridout were briefly discussed.

Property Committee showed a sample of the material suggested by Heavy Metal Roofing which could be placed over the existing material on the steeple. The estimated cost for the work would be \$80,000.

The Official Board voted to recommend that Collier Street United Church undertake a Capital & Operating Fundraising campaign of \$200,000 per year for the next 5 years by mean of a congregational committee.

The minutes will be viewable following the approval on March 1, 2017.
