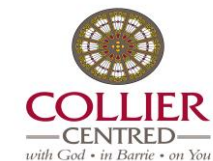
For 40 days excluding Sundays, which are considered "mini-Easters," followers of Christ's ways will draw from the spiritual well of prayer. "Prayer is where the action" is said John Wesley. *Prayer is conversation, communication and communion with God through Christ.* This is a two-way street. We talk with God and God response to us. Prayer reminds us that we are not alone.

Over the 6 weeks, we will gather in the sanctuary each Tuesdays at 12 noon under the theme "Waters of Life" for 30 minutes of worship. The service will be conducted by ministers from different denominations in Barrie. We will use the Psalms and Gospels to help us practice the spiritual discipline of prayer. To follow the way of Jesus from Galilee to Jerusalem to face the cross.

As we approach April 26, which is the last Tuesday of lent, we are reminded that Lent is not a time of boasting of one's prayer life. It is surely not a time of trying to earn God's favour or to seek an increase in God's love as well. For we know very well that God's love for us couldn't be any greater than it already is. "Prayer doesn't change the purpose of God. But prayer does change the action of God" mentioned Chuck Smith.

Lent is a journey. Prayer is a great resource to aid us on the journey, making the path fruitful and us faithful followers of love, compassion and mercy, shaping a better and more beautiful community and world. The journey continues...
